

Notice to Parents of The Grad Class of 2010

In a recent review of student attendance, we have noticed a significant rise in absenteeism, especially in our Grad Class. We have serious concerns about the negative effect missed time has on student performance. The table and graph below indicate the averages of classes in **Term II** based on the following criteria;

Students that have missed 0 to 10 classes

Students that have missed 10 to 20 classes

Students that have missed more than 20 classes

On average, there is a significant drop in academic achievement as the amount of time missed increases.

Please impress upon your child the importance of regular attendance. It may mean the difference between acceptance at their school of choice or ultimately high school graduation.
