



Notice to ALL students Writing Public Examinations

If you are not successful in one or more of your public examination courses, it is **YOUR** responsibility to follow up with the Department of Education.

1. Generally, if the mark in a course is 45 or above the first step should be to apply to the department for a re-read. You should do this **IMMEDIATELY** upon receipt of your marks. If it is unsuccessful you may still have time to apply to write the supplementary exam in August.
