

TFT Online Tutoring Initiative: 2009-2010

Presently, many schools in Newfoundland and Labrador have access to the Tutoring for Tuition program (TFT) in a face-to-face setting which provides free tutoring to students needing academic supports. In addition to these supports, the Centre for Distance Learning and Innovation (CDLI) offers a similar program in the online environment. Both programs are sponsored and funded by the Department of Human Resources, Labor and Employment.

Online tutoring service is available now to **all students** in the province of Newfoundland and Labrador and covers many high school courses including

To avail of this tutoring service:

1. Go to: www.cdli.ca/tutoring
2. Click on the "ONLINE TUTORING LINK" on the top right.
3. Download/install the Java Web Start software to your computer.
(Note: You only need to do this once, before your initial tutoring session.)
4. Click on the "Tutor Schedules" icon to view tutor schedules.
5. Go back and click on the appropriate room from room # 1-8.
6. You will log in as a guest (this will be ticked). Enter your e-mail address. For "Display Name" please put in your full name followed by your community in brackets. For the "Session Password" type in the word 'help'.
7. Click on the 'Log In' button on the bottom right.

Room 8 is the 'tutor coordinator room' where you can obtain help with the tools of the virtual classroom or access guidance on topics such as study skills and time management.
