Where is it? The main MUN campus is in St. John's, the Marine Institute is also located in St. John's, NL. The Grenfell Campus is in Corner Brook; as well MUN provides opportunities to study abroad at Harlow, England.

On campus housing is provided.

Admissions:

You have to successfully complete Academic Level III courses in these five subject areas: English, Math, a lab Science, Social Science (e.g. World Geo or History), and one other elective. You need at least an overall 70% average in grade 12.

How much does it cost? Including accommodations (on campus housing), organizational fees, and tuition = \$10,412 (for two semesters – one year)

Scholarships: Entrance scholarships are awarded to senior level students on the basis of academic performance in high school. For example, if you finish high school with an average between 85%-89.9% you are eligible to receive a \$1000 scholarship (if you have 90% you'll get \$2000), and so on...and the higher the value of the scholarship.

Become a MUN student in 10 steps:

1. Go to mun.ca/undergrad to find out about programs offered.
2. Apply by submitting an application for admissions (\$40 application fee). Make sure you include all required documents.
3. Apply for housing.
4. Wait for your information to arrive.
5. Find out about financial aid and scholarships.
6. Ask for academic advice (MUN representatives will visit Menihek to meet with you).
7. Select and register for classes.
8. Check out your orientation information.
9. Pay your fees.
10. Begin!
