How to apply:

Some faculties require an application as early as December 1st, and admission requirements for each faculty vary. For example, NL requirements to become a Glendon student include a high school diploma with 11 credits at the 3000 level, including English 3201. For some of the programs you may be required to submit supplementary information.
